ORDER ASSIGNING AD LITEM JUDGES TO THE CASE

- Callixte Kalimanzira was arrested on 8 November 2005. He pleaded not guilty to the three counts brought against him, on 11 November 2005.
- On 19 March 2008, the President scheduled the trial for commencement on 28 April 2008, and, pursuant to Rule 19(A) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, appointed a bench on 10 April 2008.² Due to new circumstances which have arisen affecting the commencement of the trial and making it necessary to change the composition of the bench, the President assigned himself as Presiding Judge on 29 April 2008.³
- 3. On 30 April 2008, following the request from the President and pursuant to Article 12ter(2) of the Statute of the Tribunal, the United Nations Secretary General appointed Judges Vagn Joensen and Gberdao Gustave Kam to the case of Kalimanzira, while withdrawing the prior appointment of Judges Florence Rita Arrey and Seon Ki Park.

FOR THOSE REASONS.

THE PRESIDENT

ASSIGNS Judges Vagn Joensen and Gherdao Gustave Karn to this case, and CONFIRMS the commencement of the trial on 5 May 2008 before Trial Chamber III.
