RECALLING the Trial Chamber's Decision of 21 April 2008 entitled "Decision on Motions for Site Visits to Rwanda", in which the Chamber ordered that certain site visits should take place du ing the week of 9 to 13 June 2008.

NOTIN 3 that the defence case for Prosper Mugiraneza is still ongoing, and that there are other de ence witnesses who may still need to be heard by the Chamber in this case;

NOTING FURTHER that, following a request by the Chamber to the Office of the Presider t for the allocation of court room space for a further four weeks from 26 May 2008, the Office of the President was able to confirm the availability of court room space from 28 May 20 8 to 13 June 2008 (inclusive);

CONSI DERING, on the basis of the aforementioned developments in the management of the case, that it is now preferable that the Chamber continues to sit in Arusha while court room space is available and allocated to it; the Chamber
