INTRODUCTION

- On 19 March 2004, the Chamber rendered a decision on a Prosecution Motion to change and extend the protective measures accorded to victims and witnesses. The Chamber held that the Defence must receive authorization from the Chamber and consent from the protected witness before it could enter into contact with a protected Prosecution Witness.1
- Witness GFA testified for the Prosecution on 30 and 31 January and 1 and 2 February 2. 2006. The Prosecution closed its case on 7 December 2006. The Defence for Bizimungu presented its case between 16 April and 14 December 2007, subject to 3 expert witnesses to be called at a later date. Since 28 April 2008, Witness GFA has been giving further testimony in the Casimir Bizimungu et al. case in accordance with a Decision by Trial Chamber II (differently composed) dated 21 April 2008, ordering Witness GFA's recall.2 On 5 May 2008, the Defence filed the present motion requesting the Chamber to ensure Witness GFA's continued presence in Arusha and seeking the Chamber's permission to meet the Witness.3 On 9 May 2008, the Prosecution filed a response opposing the Motion. On 14 May 2008, the Defence filed a Reply.5
- The Chamber notes that there are unconfirmed reports suggesting that Witness GFA 3. has left Arusha and his current whereabouts are unknown.

THE CHAMBER THEREFORE

ORDERS the Witnesses and Victims Support Section (WVSS) to clarify the situation with respect to Witness GFA's whereabouts and report back to it within 7 days of the date of this decision;

The Chamber will make, if necessary, further orders based on the information received from WVSS.
