
INTRODUCTION

1. On 14 May 2008¹, in application of Rule 91 (B) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence ("Rules"), this Chamber directed the Registrar to appoint independent *amicus curiae* to investigate the false testimony of BTH in this case, clearly specifying the scope of the concerned investigation².
2. As of today, the Chamber is not aware of any step that has been taken in that regard.


FOR THESE REASONS, THE CHAMBER

- I. **REITERATES** its **ORDER** to the Registrar to appoint an independent *amicus curiae* to investigate the false testimony of BTH in this case, in accordance with its order dated 14 May 2008, and
- II. **ORDERS** to the Registrar to report back to the Chamber on the specific step(s) the Registrar has taken in that regard as soon as possible, in any case, by the 13 August on the latest.
