

INTRODUCTION

- On 15 July 2008, Mathieu Ngirumpatse filed both a Brief and a Corrigendum, pursuant to Rule 73 ter of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence¹.
- 2. On 25 July 2008, the Prosecutor filed a Motion and Submission² requesting the Chamber to:
 - a. render moot Mathieu Ngirumpatse's submission with the redaction of the names of the witnesses,³
 - b. direct that the Prosecutor be provided with a reduced witness list, more information about each of Ngirumpatse's witnesses, an order of appearance, and estimated duration of the testimonies, and
 - order Mathieu Ngirumpatse to fulfill his obligations under Rule 73 ter upon possible penalty of sanction.
- 3. The Prosecutor also states that he is not aware of any Motion filed by Mathieu Ngirumparse seeking admission of any statement in written form under Rule 92 bis, and adds that it should not be filed ex parte.
- On 30 July 2008, Mathieu Ngirumpatse opposed the Motion⁴.

DELIBERATIONS

- 5. The Chamber recalls that it has addressed all issues raised in this Motion in its Order dated 30 July 2008.⁵ It reiterates that the Registry is ordered to re-file the concerned documents inter partes and confidentially, and that Mathieu Ngirumpatse is required to comply with his obligations.
- 6. Finally, the Chamber notes that no Motton seeking admission of any statement in written form under Rule 92 bis has been filed by Mathieu Ngirumpatse.
