## **INTERIM ORDER**

Interim Order 25 August 2008

1. On 9 June 2008, the Defence for Kalimanzira moved the Chamber to exclude

Witnesses BWM, BWN, BXB, BXC, BXD and BXL from the Prosecution Witness List on

the basis that their anticipated testimonies were related to material facts not pleaded in the

Indictment. On 24 June 2008, the Chamber decided to hear the testimonies of Witnesses BXB

and BWM, who were expected to give evidence on the Accused's alleged presence and

incitement at a roadblock in Sahera secteur and at a meeting in the Sahera secteur office,

killings which took place thereafter, and the Accused's alleged involvement in the killings at

Kabakobwa hill.

2. On 26 June 2008, the Chamber heard the testimony of Prosecution Witness BXB. On

30 June 2008, the Prosecution rested its case without calling Witness BWM.

3. Pursuant to Articles 19 and 20 of the Statute of the Tribunal, the Chamber shall

guarantee a fair and expeditious trial with full respect of the rights of the accused. Rule 54 of

the Rules of Procedure and Evidence empowers the Chamber to make orders for the conduct

of the trial, including orders with the purpose of clarifying the case which the Defence has to

answer by eliminating allegations on which no convictions could be entered based on the

evidence adduced by the Prosecution during the presentation of its case.

4. At this stage, the Chamber would like to hear from the Parties on whether there is

sufficient evidence upon which the Chamber could rely in support of the allegations at

paragraph 1 above, and what legal consequences should follow from any conclusion that may

be reached.

ACCORDINGLY, THE CHAMBER

**INVITES** the Prosecution to make its submission no later than Friday, 29 August 2008, and

INVITES the Defence for Kalimanzira to respond to the Prosecution submission no later

than Monday, 1 September 2008.
