Corrigendum to judgement and Sentence

THE CHAMBER¹, noting that there is a typographical error in a date mentioned at Paragraph 415 of Annex I to the Judgement of 12 November 2008 in the *Prosecutor v.* Siméon Nchamihigo which reads as follows:

"As for the filing of the closing briefs, the Chamber decided on 21 September 2007 that they should be filed on 3 December 2007, and informed the Parties that oral closing arguments should not exceed two hours in duration, respectively. On 26 November 2007, the Chamber granted an extension of time for seven days. The two closing briefs were filed on 11 December 2007. The Defence also filed a corrigendum on 4 January 2008, and then a reply to the Prosecution Closing Brief on 17 January 2007. On 23 January 2008, the Parties presented their oral arguments."

CORRECTS this paragraph and DECIDES that Paragraph 415 should read as follows:
