

1. The Trial in this case commenced on 22 April 2009 and was adjourned on 28 April 2009. The second session was scheduled from 1st until 12 June 2009 and the Prosecution was supposed to finish the presentation of its case by calling its 11 last witnesses.
2. On the 24 May 2009, both parties informally proposed to postpone the resumption of the trial until 3 June 2009.
3. Considering that on 25 May 2009, the Chamber granted the Prosecution motion in reduction of its witness list from 11 to four last witnesses, pursuant to Rule 73bis(E) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (RPE hereinafter),¹ the Chamber:
SCHEDULES the trial in this case to resume on 3 June 2008.
