DECISION ON MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO COMPLETE CERTIFICATIONS

1. On 15 July 2009, the Chamber rendered a decision on Joseph Nzirorera's motions for the admission of written statements and transcripts of testimony pursuant to Rule 92 *bis* of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence.¹ The Chamber ordered Nzirorera to obtain the certifications required by Rule 92 *bis* (B) within 45 days of the date of the 92 *bis* Decision.²

2. Joseph Nzirorera now moves for an extension of time to obtain the certifications, until 30 September 2008.³ Nzirorera submits that more time is necessary to arrange for travel to Europe, and because some witnesses in Rwanda were unavailable when the certifying officer travelled there recently.⁴

3. The Chamber accepts Joseph Nzirorera's submissions regarding the necessity of additional time for obtaining the certifications. The Chamber finds that the remaining certifications should be obtained by 30 September 2009.

FOR THESE REASONS, THE CHAMBER

- I. GRANTS Joseph Nzirorera's Motion; and
- II. ORDERS Joseph Nzirorera to obtain the remaining certifications, as prescribed by Rule 92 bis (B), by 30 September 2009.
