# ORDER CONCERNING JOSEPH NZIRORERA'S SUBMISSION ON VIOLATION OF HIS RIGHTS

1. On 6 August 2009, Joseph Nzirorera filed submissions concerning the alleged violations of his rights which have occurred since his arrest.<sup>1</sup> The Prosecution responded to the merits of the Submission.<sup>2</sup>

2. The Chamber notes that Joseph Nzirorera is not seeking a ruling on his Submission now, but rather requests that the Chamber take it into consideration at the time of the final judgement in these proceedings.<sup>3</sup> As such, the Submission is really a closing brief and the Chamber finds that it has been improperly filed at this stage of the proceedings. Accepting closing arguments in a piecemeal fashion could lead to unfairness and confusion and, consequently, the Chamber will not consider it. Joseph Nzirorera may include the arguments contained in the Submission in his closing brief, subject to any word limitations that may later be ordered.

## FOR THESE REASONS, THE CHAMBER

**DISMISSES** Joseph Nzirorera's Submission on Violation of his Rights in its entirety.
