
1. On 5 February 2010, the Prosecution filed an amended Indictment. On 9 February 2010, the Accused pled not-guilty to all counts at a further appearance. Subsequently, the Chamber met with the Parties on 12 February 2010 at an informal meeting to discuss preparation for trial.

2. At that meeting, the Prosecution indicated it would file its Pre-Trial Brief by 15 March 2010. However, since the Prosecution team is also engaged in the *Kanyarukiga* case, the Chamber decided that it would grant a one-week extension to the filing of the Pre-Trial Brief should there be a site visit in that case prior to 15 March 2010.

FOR THESE REASONS, THE CHAMBER


ORDERS the Prosecution to file the following no later than 15 March 2010 unless a site visit in the *Kanyarukiga* case takes place before that time, in which case, the Chamber grants a one-week extension: (i) its pre-trial brief, addressing the factual and legal issues, (ii) any admission by the Parties, (iii) a statement of contested matters of law and fact, (iv) a list of intended witnesses in the proposed order of appearance and (v) a list of exhibits stating whenever possible whether the Defence has any objection to the authenticity, and any other material required in Rule 73*bis*.
