I, CARMEL AGIUS, Judge of the Appeals Chamber of the International Criminal Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Genocide and Other Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of Rwanda and Rwandan Citizens Responsible for Genocide and Other Such Violations Committed in the Territory of Neighbouring States Between 1 January and 31 December 1994 ("Appeals Chamber" and "Tribunal", respectively), and Pre-Appeal Judge in this case,

NOTING the Trial Judgement rendered by Trial Chamber I of the Tribunal against Tharcisse Renzaho on 14 July 2009;¹

NOTING the Notice of Appeal against the Trial Judgement filed by Mr. Renzaho on 2 October 2009;²

NOTING the Appellant's Brief filed confidentially by Mr. Renzaho on 2 March 2010,³ the Respondent's Brief filed by the Prosecution on 12 April 2010⁴ and the Brief in Reply filed by Mr. Renzaho on 5 May 2010;⁵

NOTING the *Requête en modification de la notice d'appel*, filed by Mr. Renzaho on 5 May 2010 ("Motion");

NOTING paragraph 13 of the Practice Direction on Procedure for the Filing of Written Submissions in Appeal Proceedings Before the Tribunal ("Practice Direction") which provides that the opposite party shall file a response to a motion within ten days of its filing;

NOTING paragraph 14 of the Practice Direction which provides that the moving party may file a reply to such response within four days of its filing;

CONSIDERING Rule 108 *bis* of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, paragraph 19 of the Practice Direction and the need for this appeal to proceed expeditiously;

ORDER the Prosecution to file its response to the Motion, if any, no later than 10 May 2010;


FURTHER ORDER Mr. Renzaho to file a reply to the Prosecution response, if any, no later than 12 May 2010.
