1. The Chamber has reviewed Joseph Nzirorera's expected order of appearance for remaining witnesses, filed on 26 April 2010.<sup>1</sup> The Chamber has also consulted with counsel for Nzirorera and counsel for Mathieu Ngirumpatse.
2. The Chamber recognizes that the order of appearance of Joseph Nzirorera's witnesses is often dynamic because of travel complications and other externalities. However, the Chamber also acknowledges that the Witnesses and Victims Support Section cannot work efficiently with Mathieu Ngirumpatse to bring in his witnesses without a clear date for the beginning of his defence case. Accordingly, the Chamber finds that the following schedule best serves the interests of justice:


Beginning of Nzirorera's direct examination -	7 June 2010
Beginning of Nzirorera's cross examination -	21 June 2010
Beginning of Ngirumpatse's defence case -	5 July 2010


3. Joseph Nzirorera will be permitted to request leave to present any witnesses that were approved by the Chamber who were unable to testify by 1 July 2010. In addressing such a request, if any, the Chamber will take into consideration the need for Mathieu Ngirumpatse to present his case without unnecessary disruption.


**FOR THE ABOVE REASONS, THE CHAMBER**

**ORDERS** that Joseph Nzirorera's direct examination begin on 7 June 2010 and cross examination begin on 21 June 2010, and that Mathieu Ngirumpatse's defence case begin on 5 July 2010.
