
1. On 26 April 2010, Tharcisse Muvunyi moved the Chamber to reclassify the affidavit of a witness as strictly confidential.¹ The Prosecution responded on 3 May 2010, requesting that the Chamber direct Muvunyi to lodge his application with the Appeals Chamber because it is currently seized of his case.²
2. However, the Court Management Services section of the Tribunal informed the Chamber on 27 April 2010 that it had reclassified the document at issue as strictly confidential. Accordingly, the Chamber now dismisses the Motion as moot.

FOR THE ABOVE REASONS, THE CHAMBER

DISMISSES the Motion as moot.
