I, PATRICK ROBINSON, Judge of the Appeals Chamber of the International Criminal Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Genocide and Other Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of Rwanda and Rwandan Citizens Responsible for Genocide and Other Such Violations Committed in the Territory of Neighbouring States Between 1 January and 31 December 1994 ("Appeals Chamber" and "Tribunal", respectively), and Pre-Appeal Judge in this case; ¹

NOTING the Judgement pronounced in this case by Trial Chamber I of the Tribunal on 25 February 2010 and filed in writing on 1 March 2010;

NOTING the "Notice of Appeal", filed by Ephrem Setako on 12 April 2010 ("Setako"); "Ephrem Setako's Appellant's Brief", filed confidentially on 8 September 2010; the "Prosecutor's Respondent's Brief", filed on 18 October 2010; ² the "Appellant's Brief-in-Reply", filed confidentially by Setako on 2 November 2011; and the "Corrigendum to Appellant's Brief-in-Reply", filed confidentially by Setako on 3 November 2011;

NOTING the Scheduling Order of 15 March 2011, whereby the Appeals Chamber ordered that the appeal hearing in the present case shall take place on Tuesday, 29 March 2011, in Arusha, Tanzania;

CONSIDERING that all submissions filed before this Tribunal shall be public unless there are exceptional reasons for keeping them confidential³ and that parties shall file public redacted versions of all confidential briefs filed on appeal;⁴

HEREBY ORDER Setako to file public redacted versions of his appellant's brief, brief in reply, and corrigendum to his brief in reply, or to indicate that there is no basis for maintaining the confidentiality thereof, no later than 25 March 2011;

ORDER that any changes to the confidential versions of the above briefs shall be limited to necessary redactions of confidential information, including the identities of protected witnesses, and shall not consist of any additions, deletions, or other amendments;
