**THE APPEALS CHAMBER** of the International Criminal Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Genocide and Other Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of Rwanda and Rwandan Citizens Responsible for Genocide and Other Such Violations Committed in the Territory of Neighbouring States, between 1 January and 31 December 1994 (“Appeals Chamber” and “Tribunal”, respectively);

**RECALLING** the Scheduling Order issued by the Appeals Chamber on 15 March 2011, which set the date of the appeal hearing in this case on Tuesday, 29 March 2011 and informed the Parties of the timetable of the hearing;

**CONSIDERING** the need to ensure that the time allotted for the appeal hearing is used as efficiently as possible;

**EMPHASIZING** that the present order in no way expresses the Appeals Chamber’s views on the merits of the appeals;

**HEREBY INFORMS** the Parties that, during the course of the hearing and without prejudice to any other matter that the Parties or the Appeals Chamber may wish to address, the Defence is invited to discuss, with reference to the record, the following issue:


*The trial record contains a substantial number of documents from Rwandan judicial proceedings, which were tendered into evidence by the Defence at trial. The Defence is invited to indicate which of these documents are relevant to Setako’s allegation that no killings occurred at Mukamira camp on 25 April and 11 May 1994.*
