INTRODUCTION

- 1. On 18 February 2011, the Chamber ordered the Parties to file any submissions in respect of the Prosecutor's application for the preservation of evidence, pursuant to Rule 71bis of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (the "Rules"), within 14 days of the assignment of Duty Counsel. The Chamber also directed the Registrar to immediately assign a Duty Counsel to represent the interests of the fugitive Accused, Augustin Bizimana. The Registrar a signed the Duty Counsel on 16 March 2011.
- 2. The Duty Counsel now seeks an extension of the deadline for the filing of her submissior s.³ She explains that she was absent from Tanzania at the time of her assignment, that she of ly returned on 22 March 2011, and that she has not yet had sufficient time to familiarise herself with the details of the case or to prepare her submissions.

- 3. Pur suant to Rule 54, a Chamber may issue such orders as may be necessary for the purposes clan investigation or for the preparation or conduct of a trial.
- 4. In ight of the Duty Counsel's explanations, the Chamber deems it necessary to grant her an add tional week for the filing of her submissions.

GRANTS the Motion and

ORDERS the Duty Counsel to file her submissions, if any, in respect of the Prosecutor's application for the preservation of evidence via special depositions, by 6 April 2011.
