

1. Following an informal conference conducted with the Prosecution and the Duty Counsel on 30 March 2011, and having assessed their state of readiness, I am satisfied that both Parties will be in a position to commence the special deposition proceedings by 16 May 2011.

FOR THESE REASONS, I

- I. ORDER** that the special deposition proceedings, pursuant to Rule 71*bis* (K) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, will commence on **Monday, 16 May 2011** and will continue until the depositions of all the Prosecution witnesses are recorded. The proceedings will take place from Monday through Thursday each week, with a break during the week of 6 to 10 June 2011.
- II. REQUEST** the Registrar, in accordance with the requirements of Rule 71*bis* (K)(iv) and (v), to make appropriate arrangements for the recording of the depositions.
