

1. Due to unforeseen circumstances that have just arisen, it will not be possible for the special deposition proceedings in this case to commence on 16 May 2011 as previously ordered.¹ Instead, the proceedings will commence on Monday, 23 May 2011.

FOR THESE REASONS, I

- I. **VARY** the Scheduling Order of 30 March 2011;
- II. **ORDER** that the special deposition proceedings, pursuant to Rule 71 *bis* (K) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, will commence on **Monday, 23 May 2011** and will continue until the depositions of all the Prosecution witnesses are recorded. The proceedings will take place from Monday through Thursday each week, with a break during the week of 6 to 10 June 2011; and
- III. **REQUEST** the Registrar, in accordance with the requirements of Rule 71 *bis* (K)(iv) and (v), to make appropriate arrangements for the recording of the depositions.
