**THE INTERNATIONAL CRIMINAL TRIBUNAL FOR RWANDA** (the “Tribunal”),

**SITTING** as Trial Chamber II composed of Judges William H. Sekule, Presiding, Solomy Balungi Bossa and Mparany Rajohnson (the “Chamber”);

**CONSIDERING** the Statute of the Tribunal (the “Statute”) and the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (the “Rules”);

**RECALLING** that:

1. The Defence case commenced on 16 November 2010, and has spanned two sessions so far: from 16 November through 14 December 2010, and from 3 February through 14 February 2011; and
2. On 28 February 2011, the Chamber scheduled the next session of the Defence case to commence on 6 June 2011;<sup>1</sup>


**CONSIDERING** that, due to unforeseen circumstances that have just arisen, it will not be possible for the next session of the Defence case to commence on the scheduled date;

**THE CHAMBER HEREBY:**

**VARIES** the Scheduling Order of 28 February 2011; and

**ORDERS** that the Defence case-in-chief be rescheduled to resume on 13 June 2011.


