## DESIGNATION OF A TRIAL CHAMBER TO CONSIDER ELIÉZER NIYITEGEKA'S MOTION FOR DISCLOSURE

1. On 10 May 2011 the Appeals Chamber denied a Motion for disclosure pursuant to Rule 68 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence filed by Eliézer Niyitegeka.<sup>1</sup> The Appeals Chamber dismissed Niyitegeka's Motion for lack of jurisdiction as Niyitegeka's case is not pending before the Appeals Chamber. The Appeals Chamber added the Niyitegeka should file the motion with the President of the Tribunal so the matter can be assigned to an appropriate Chamber. The Appeals Chamber further indicated that it does not see any reason to treat a Rule 68 application differently from a Rule 75 application when a motion is filed in a case that no Chamber is seized of.<sup>2</sup>

2. On 15 May 2011, Eliézer Niyitegeka filed his motion before the President so she appoints a Trial Chamber to rule on the issues therein.<sup>3</sup>

## FOR THESE REASONS, THE PRESIDENT

**DESIGNATES** Trial Chamber III composed of Judge Khalida Rachid Khan, Judge Lee Gacuiga Muthoga and Judge Seon Ki Park to adjudicate on Eliézer Niyitegeka's Motion.
