- 1. On 2 April 2012, the Prosecution filed a motion requesting that the case of the fugitive-Accused Ladislas Ntaganzwa be transferred to Rwanda pursuant to Rule 11 bis of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence. The Prosecution further requests that the President assign a bench to consider its application.¹
- 2. Having reviewed the Motion, the President decides to assign himself Judge Vagn Joensen (Presiding), Judge Rita Florence Arrey, and Judge Seon Ki Park, to adjudicate on the matter.

FOR THESE REASONS, THE PRESIDENT

DESIGNATES himself, Judge Vagn Joensen (Presiding), Judge Rita Florence Arrey and Judge Seon Ki Park, to adjudicate the Motion.

DIRECTS the Registry to appoint Duty Counsel to represent the interests of the fugitive-Accused.
