INTRODUCTION



- 1. On 9 November 2011, the Prosecution filed in English a request, pursuant to Rule 11 bis of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (the "Rules"), to transfer the case of *The Prosecutor v. Bernard Munyagishari*, ICTR Case No. 2005-89-I to the Republic of Rwanda ("11 bis Motion"). The Defence filed its response to the 11 bis Motion on 1 February 2012 ("Defence Response") and an addendum on 3 February 2012 ("Defence Addendum"). The Prosecution filed its consolidated reply to the Defence Response on 29 February 2012 ("Prosecution Reply").
- 2. On 7 March 2012, the Chamber issued a scheduling order for a hearing on the referral of the case to Rwanda for 12 April 2012 ("Scheduling Order").⁴ On 10 April 2012, the Defence filed a request that the Chamber grant right of audience to its legal assistant in order that she may appear on behalf of Bernard Munyagishari at the hearing.⁵
- 3. The Prosecution has not yet filed a response and the period to do so has not yet elapsed. However, the Chamber considers that the immediate adjudication of the Motion is in the interests of justice and will assist in the fair and expeditious conduct of proceedings. 7

DISCUSSION

4. The Chamber notes that Ms. Ivanović has previously been granted right of audience to appear before the International Court of Justice and the International Criminal Tribunal for the Former Yugoslavia. In light of the Defence Request, the Chamber considers there sufficient grounds to grant Ms. Natacha Fauveau Ivanović the right of audience to appear before it on behalf of Bernard Munyagishari on 12 April 2012.
