

1. On 9 May 2012, the Prosecution filed a motion requesting that the case of Charles Ryandikayo, a fugitive, be transferred to Rwanda pursuant to Rule 11 *bis* of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence. Therein it requests that the President assign a Trial Chamber to consider its application.¹
2. Having reviewed the Motion, the President considers that a Trial Chamber shall be designated to adjudicate on the matter.

FOR THESE REASONS, THE PRESIDENT

- I. **DESIGNATES** Judges Vagn Joensen, presiding, Florence Rita Arrey and Gberdao Gustave Kam to adjudicate the Motion.
- II. **DIRECTS** the Registry to appoint a Duty Counsel to represent the interests of Charles Ryandikayo for these proceedings.
