- On 10 May 2012, this Bench directed Duty Counsel for Aloys Ndimbati to file written submissions in response to the Prosecution's Motion to transfer Ndimbati's case to Rwanda pursuant to Rule 11 bis of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence¹, within 14 days of his appointment.²
- Duty Counsel signed his letter of acceptance on 11 May 2012.
- 3. It came to the Chamber's attention that Duty Counsel was only served with such Motion on 29 May 2012. Therefore, the Chamber considers it is in the interest of justice to grant him proprio motu an extension of time to file his response.

FOR THESE REASONS, THE CHAMBER

- I. **GRANTS** Duty Counsel an extension of time to file his response to the Prosecution's Motion;
- II. **ORDERS** the Duty Counsel to file his submissions in response to the Prosecution's request by Tuesday 19 June 2012;
- III. ORDERS the Prosecution to file any reply to these submissions within five days thereafter.
