THE INTERNATIONAL CRIMINAL TRIBUNAL FOR RWANDA (the “Tribunal”),

SITTING as Trial Chamber II composed of Judges William H. Sekule, Presiding, Solomy Balungi Bossa, and Mparany Rajohnson (the “Chamber”);

RECALLING that Closing Arguments are scheduled for 23 and 24 July 2012;¹

RECALLING further that the Chamber directed the Registry to establish a video-link with Montréal, Canada in order to enable the participation of Defence Lead Counsel in the Closing Arguments on 23 and 24 July 2012;²

OBSERVING that the Parties have already been informed that they could address any supplemental and specific matters during the Closing Arguments;³

NOTING the correspondence from the Prosecution on 26 June 2012;⁴ and

ACTING pursuant to Rules 54 and 86 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence;

THE CHAMBER ORDERS that Closing Arguments take place in accordance with the following schedule:


Prosecution Closing Argument:	Three hours
Defence Closing Argument:	Three hours
Prosecution Closing Argument (rebuttal):	One hour
Defence Closing Argument (rejoinder):	One hour


