I, Fausto POCAR, Judge of the Appeals Chamber of the International Criminal Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Genocide and Other Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of Rwanda and Rwandan Citizens Responsible for Genocide and Other Such Violations Committed in the Territory of Neighbouring States Between 1 January and 31 December 1994 ("Tribunal") and Pre-Appeal Judge in this case;<sup>1</sup>

**NOTING** the Trial Judgement pronounced in this case by Trial Chamber II of the Tribunal on 24 June 2011 and issued in writing in English on 14 July 2011;<sup>2</sup>

**NOTING** the notice of appeal filed by Élie Ndayambaje ("Ndayambaje") on 8 April 2013;<sup>3</sup> the appeal brief filed confidentially by Ndayambaje on 8 April 2013;<sup>4</sup> the response brief filed confidentially by the Prosecution on 21 August 2013;<sup>5</sup> and the brief in reply filed confidentially by Ndayambaje on 25 September 2013;<sup>6</sup>

**CONSIDERING** that all submissions filed before the Tribunal shall be public unless there are exceptional reasons for keeping them confidential and that parties shall file public redacted versions of all confidential briefs filed on appeal;<sup>7</sup>

NOTING that Ndayambaje has not yet filed the public redacted version of his reply brief;

**HEREBY ORDER** Ndayambaje to file, no later than on 20 November 2013, a public redacted version of the Ndayambaje Reply Brief or to indicate that the confidentiality of his brief can be lifted, if there is no basis for maintaining the confidentiality thereof; and

**ORDER** Ndayambaje to clearly mark the redactions in the text of the public version of his brief and to limit redactions to confidential information, including the identities of protected witnesses, and not make any additions, deletions, or other amendments.
