**THE APPEALS CHAMBER** of the International Criminal Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Genocide and Other Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of Rwanda and Rwandan Citizens Responsible for Genocide and Other Such Violations Committed in the Territory of Neighbouring States Between 1 January and 31 December 1994 (“Appeals Chamber” and “Tribunal”, respectively);

**NOTING** the Trial Judgement pronounced in this case by Trial Chamber II of the Tribunal on 24 June 2011 and issued in writing in English on 14 July 2011;<sup>1</sup>

**NOTING** that Pauline Nyiramasuhuko, Arsène Shalom Ntahobali, Sylvain Nsabimana, Alphonse Nteziryayo, Joseph Kanyabashi, Élie Ndayambaje, and the Prosecution lodged appeals against the Trial Judgement, and that the filing of their appeal submissions is complete;

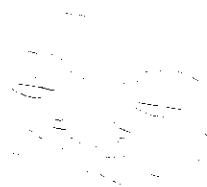
**PURSUANT** to Rule 114 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal;
