
THE TRIAL CHAMBER

HAVING HEARD AND CONSIDERED the oral arguments of the Prosecutor and the Defence during a closed session held on Wednesday 21 June 1995; and

PURSUANT TO Rule 54 and Rule 98,

HEREBY ORDERS:

- (1) the parties shall file by Monday 3 July 1995 additional factual information concerning prior media contact by the witnesses for whom protective measures are sought, together with legal argument as to the relevance of any such prior contact to the protection now requested;
- (2) such factual information may be presented in any physical format capable of being read or viewed by the Trial Chamber and shall, if necessary, be accompanied by a translation into one of the working languages of the Tribunal;
- (3) the parties shall file by Monday 10 July 1995 any written response to such filings;
- (4) the Prosecutor shall file by Monday 3 July 1995 amended prayers for relief numbers (3) and (11) of his Motion filed 18 May 1995 requesting protective measures for victims and witnesses;
- (5) the Defence shall file by Monday 10 July 1995 its response to such amended prayers;
- (6) the Prosecutor shall provide the Defence by Wednesday 28 June 1995 with redacted versions of the statements of the witnesses for whom protective measures are sought, pending the decision of the Trial Chamber on the Motion requesting protective measures for victims and witnesses; and
- (7) if the Defence requires information with respect to any witness which would enable it to accept that the witness may, in all other respects, remain anonymous, it should file a request for such information no later than Wednesday 5 July 1995.
