
THE TRIAL CHAMBER

HAVING CONSIDERED the Motion for Leave to Amend the Indictment filed by the Prosecutor on 31 July 1995, and

PURSUANT TO RULE 50,

HEREBY ORDERS the Prosecutor to submit the Motion for Leave to Amend the Indictment, together with supporting material, to Judge Karibi-Whyte for the entry of such orders as he deems appropriate.

THE TRIAL CHAMBER shall set a timetable for any response by the Defence to the amended indictment and to the Motion for Protective Measures for a Witness, and for the entry of a plea by the accused in respect of any new charges that may be confirmed, only after the Motion for Leave to Amend the Indictment has been considered by Judge Karibi-Whyte.
