THE TRIAL CHAMBER

HAVING CONSIDERED the application filed on 31 July 1995 by the Office of the Prosecutor requesting that the hearing of its Motion concerning protective measures for a witness set down for hearing on 25 October 1995 be held *in camera*, the Response thereto filed by the Defence on 28 September 1995, and the Reply filed by the Office of the Prosecutor on 6 October 1995, and


CONSIDERING it appropriate to grant relief for reasons of the safety, security or non-disclosure of the identity of the witness and the protection of the interests of justice, and

WITH THE CONSENT OF THE PARTIES

PURSUANT TO Rule 75 (B) and Rule 79 (A)(ii)

HEREBY ORDERS:

- (1) the hearing of the Prosecutor's motion for protective measures for a witness, set down for 25 October 1995 shall be in closed session;
- (2) only counsel of record shall be admitted to such session;
- (3) pursuant to Rule 81 (A), video and audio recordings of the hearing will be made for the purposes of the record, however, such record shall not be released until further order of the Trial Chamber.
