DECISION TO VACATE IN PART THE ORDER FOR NON-DISCLOSURE

I, Lal Chand Vohrah, Judge of the International Criminal Tribunal for the former Yugoslavia,

CONSIDERING the order of Judge Gabrielle Kirk McDonald of 10 November 1995, which ordered the non-disclosure of the indictment IT-95-16-I,

UPON HEARING the submissions of the Prosecutor requesting that the order of non-disclosure of 10 November 1995 be vacated in part to allow service of the arrest warrants upon the Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina,

CONSIDERING that this request would require that the order of 10 November 1995 be vacated in respect of the indictment which must be transmitted to the said Republic, pursuant to Rule 55 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence,

BEING SATISFIED THAT this request is necessary for the purpose of the ongoing investigation and for the preparation of the trial,

PURSUANT TO Rule 54 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence,
ORDER that the order of non-disclosure of 10 November 1995 be vacated in part insofar as there shall be disclosure of the indictment IT-95-16-I only for the purpose of service of the arrest warrants upon the Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina,
