CONSIDERING the order of Judge Gabrielle Kirk McDonald of 10 November 1995, which ordered the non-disclosure of the indictment IT-95-15-I,

UPON HEARING, pursuant to Rule 54 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, the submissions of the Prosecutor, requesting that the order of non-disclosure of 10 November 1995 be vacated in part to allow service of the arrest warrants upon the Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina,

CONSIDERING that this request would require that the order of 10 November 1995 be vacated in respect of the indictment, and the review of the indictment in Case No. IT-95-15-I, which must be transmitted to the said Republic, pursuant to Rule 55 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence,

PURSUANT TO Rule 54 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence,

ORDER that the order of non-disclosure of 10 November 1995 be vacated in respect of the following documents:

to the extent only to allow service of the arrest warrant upon the Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina in accordance with Rule 55 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence.
