THE TRIAL CHAMBER


HAVING HEARD THE PARTIES and having considered the submissions of the Defence that, in view of the considerable difficulties experienced by it in completing its investigations, the trial should not commence until May 1996

HEREBY PURSUANT TO RULE 54

ORDERS:

- (1) the Parties shall each file by Friday 15 March 1996 a written report to the Chamber giving details of:
 - (i) in the case of the Defence, the efforts made to that date to complete its investigations;
in the case of both Parties,
 - (ii) the results of the discussions between the parties seeking to reach agreement on the presentation of evidence by the expert witness, Dr. Gow; and
 - (iii) any other matter that will assist the Chamber in expediting the conduct of the trial;
- (2)(a) the Office of the Prosecutor shall file its pre-trial brief, including argument as to the elements of the offences charged and the nature and degree of evidence necessary to support such charges, by Tuesday 9 April 1996;
 - (b) the Defence shall file its pre-trial brief and response by Tuesday 23 April 1996;
 - (c) should the Office of the Prosecutor wish to submit a reply, it shall be filed by Tuesday 30 April 1996;
- (3) a further status conference shall be held on 2 April 1996 at 10 a.m;
- (4) a final pre-trial conference shall be held on Friday 4 May 1996 at 10 a.m;
- (5) the matter is hereby set down for trial on Tuesday 7 May 1996 at 10 a.m.

No further extension of time is envisaged.
