

ORDER FOR DETENTION OF GENERAL DJORDE DJUKIC

I, Judge Adolphus Godwin Karibi-Whyte, Judge of the International Criminal Tribunal for the former Yugoslavia,

HAVING confirmed the indictment against Djorde Djukic submitted by the Prosecutor on 29 February 1996,

CONSIDERING that at the time of the signing of this Order, the accused is currently detained at the Seat of the Tribunal,

HEREBY ORDER, pursuant to Rule 54 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal, that the accused continue to be held in the United Nations Detention Unit in The Hague until he be brought, without delay, before Trial Chamber I for further proceedings in accordance with the requirements of Rules 62 and 64 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal,

DECIDES that for these purposes the present Order shall be my sufficient warrant.
