APPLICATION FOR A TRANSFER ORDER AND ORDER FOR DETENTION OF RADOSLAV KREMONOVIĆ AND DRAZEN ERDEMOVIĆ

ORDER FOR DETENTION OF RADOSLAV KREMONOVIĆ AND DRAZEN ERDEMOVIĆ

I, Judge Fouad Riad, of the International Criminal Tribunal for the former Yugoslavia,

NOTING the Application of the Deputy Prosecutor, dated 28 March 1996, for orders of transfer and detention in respect of Radoslav KREMENOVIĆ and Drazen ERDEMOVIĆ,

CONSIDERING that the personal appearance as witnesses of Radoslav KREMENOVIĆ and Drazen ERDEMOVIĆ has been requested by the Tribunal so that a record of their statement may be taken in connection with an investigation being carried on by the Prosecutor concerning alleged crimes over which the Tribunal has jurisdiction,

CONSIDERING that Radoslav KREMENOVIĆ and Drazen ERDEMOVIĆ have been charged with crimes against the Criminal Code of the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia, and are presently being lawfully detained pending the completion of investigations by the criminal authorities of the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia, namely the investigative judge in charge of the District Court of Novi Sad;

CONSIDERING that the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia has agreed to allow Radoslav KREMENOVIĆ and Drazen ERDEMOVIĆ to leave the jurisdiction and custody of the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia and be placed into the jurisdiction and custody of the Tribunal for purposes of the Prosecutor's investigation and provided they are returned to the jurisdiction and custody of the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia upon conclusion of the Prosecutor's questioning, or at an earlier date should they no longer be required for the Prosecutor's investigation, or unless otherwise ordered by a Judge or Trial Chamber of the Tribunal, and in any event on a date which does not extend the period of their detention as foreseen by the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia;

CONSIDERING the presence of the said Radoslav KREMENOVIĆ and Drazen ERDEMOVIĆ is not required for any criminal proceedings in progress in the territory of the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia during the period Radoslav KREMENOVIĆ and Drazen ERDEMOVIĆ are required by the Tribunal,

CONSIDERING the transfer of Radoslav KREMENOVIĆ and Drazen ERDEMOVIĆ will not extend the period of their detention as foreseen by the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia;

PURSUANT to Rules 54 and 90 bis of the Rules.

ORDER the detention in custody of Radoslav KREMENOVIĆ and Drazen ERDEMOVIĆ in the United Nations Detention Facility in The Hague, The Netherlands and enjoin the Commanding Officer of that Detention Unit to receive Radoslav KREMENOVIĆ and Drazen ERDEMOVIĆ and to detain them in custody until the conclusion of the Prosecutor's questioning, or at an earlier date should they no longer be required for the Prosecutor's investigation, or unless otherwise ordered by a Judge or Trial Chamber of the Tribunal, and in any event for a period which does not extend the period of their detention as foreseen by the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia;
