CONSIDERING the decision of Judge Lal Chand Vohrah to vacate in part an order for non-disclosure of the indictment IT-95-15-I for the purpose of service of the arrest warrants upon the Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina,

UPON HEARING the submissions on behalf of the Prosecution requesting that the order of non-disclosure of 10 November 1995 be further vacated in part to allow the disclosure of the names of the witnesses set forth in the confirming material to the appropriate law enforcement agencies,

BEING SATISFIED THAT this request is necessary for the purpose of the ongoing investigation and for the preparation of the trial,
