

THE TRIAL CHAMBER

HAVING CONSIDERED the Prosecutor's pre-trial brief filed on 10 April 1996, the response of the Defence to the Prosecutor's pre-trial brief filed on 23 April 1996 and the Prosecutor's reply to the response of the Defence to the Prosecutor's pre-trial brief filed on 26 April 1996;
