THE TRIAL CHAMBER,

NOTING its previous Decisions on the Defence Motions to Protect Defence Witnesses issued on 25 June, 16 August and 20 September 1996,


NOTING that the request set forth in the current Motion has been addressed in those Decisions, in which the Trial Chamber has explained at length its reasons,
