ORDER PURSUANT TO RULE 54

I, Adolphus Godwin Karibi-Whyte, Judge of the International Criminal Tribunal for the Former Yugoslavia;

NOTING the indictment against Željko Meakić and others dated 10 February 1995 which I confirmed on 13 February 1995 ("Indictment");

NOTING the Order of 25 November 1996 ("Order") by which I invited the Prosecutor to submit by 2 December 1996, or 9 December 1996 if Rule 60 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence ("Rules") had not already been activated, a report on the measures taken to effect personal service of the Indictment;

NOTING the communication, dated 2 December 1996, by which the Prosecutor informed me that Rule 60 has not been activated in respect of the indictment;

CONSIDERING that the Order invites the Prosecutor to immediately initiate the procedure under Rule 60 if this had not already been done in relation to the indictment;

CONSIDERING FURTHER that the time set by the Order for a full compliance with the invitations therein set out has not expired;

FOR THESE REASONS AND PURSUANT TO RULE 54,

REITERATE the invitation set out in the Order that the Prosecutor should immediately initiate the procedure envisaged by Rule 60 in relation to the Indictment;

REITERATE the invitation set out in the Order that the Prosecutor should submit a written report on the measures taken to effect personal service of the Indictment by 9 December 1996;

NOTE the Prosecutor's request, as expressed in the communication, that any Rule 61 hearing to be held in relation to this indictment should not be fixed for a date prior to the middle of February 1997.
