# I, Gabrielle Kirk McDonald, Judge of the International Criminal Tribunal for the Former Yugoslavia;

**NOTING** the indictment against Zoran Marinić ("the accused") dated 2 November 1995 which I confirmed on 10 November 1995 ("Indictment");

**NOTING** the Order of 20 November 1996 by which I invited the Prosecutor to submit a report on the measures taken to effect personal service of the Indictment in accordance with Sub-rule 61(A) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence ("Rules");

**NOTING** the report dated 13 December 1996 ("Report") which the Prosecutor submitted in compliance with the said Order;

**CONSIDERING** that the said Report states that the Registrar transmitted warrants for the arrest of the accused to the Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina on 8 December 1995 and to the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina and the Republic of Croatia on 1 July 1996;

**CONSIDERING** that the Report states further that the Prosecutor has requested the Registrar to transmit a form of advertisement of the Indictment to the national authorities of the States in which the Prosecutor believes the accused may be found, for publication in the national newspapers of the territories concerned, and that the Registrar has so transmitted the said form of advertisement;

**CONSIDERING** that it appears from the Report that the Prosecutor has taken all reasonable measures to inform the accused of the existence of the Indictment, thus satisfying the requirements stipulated in Sub-rule 61(A);

#### FOR THESE REASONS, PURSUANT TO RULE 54 AND SUB-RULE 61(B),

**ORDER** the Prosecutor to submit the Indictment to Trial Chamber II together with all the evidence that was before me on confirmation of the Indictment for a public hearing;

**INVITE** the Prosecutor, in the best interests of justice, to attend a status conference at 10.15 a.m. on 7 January 1997, in Chambers, upon which, and after consultation with the other Judges of Trial Chamber II and the Registry the date of the said public hearing will be set.
