TRIAL CHAMBER II,

HAVING CONSIDERED the Sentencing Notice filed by counsel for Duško Tadić on 9 June 1997 (Registry Page nos. D17718-D17714);

NOTING that the Pre-Sentencing Hearing scheduled to begin on 17 June 1997 must be rescheduled to afford additional time for the transport of witnesses to the hearing;

HEREBY

RESCHEDULES the Pre-Sentencing Hearing for a commencement date of 30 June 1997 at 10:00 a.m. and the Sentencing for 14 July 1997 at 10:00 a.m.;

DIRECTS the parties to coordinate immediately with the Victims and Witnesses Unit if assistance is needed for the transport of witnesses to the Pre-Sentencing Hearing;

DECIDES that the parties may offer written statements or reports as well as oral statements during the Pre-Sentencing Hearing;

DIRECTS the parties to submit written statements in lieu of oral statements whenever possible;


DECIDES that any written statements or reports offered by the parties will be received and considered by the Trial Chamber in a manner equivalent to oral statements;

DECIDES that it will receive only reports, written statements, and oral statements which provide relevant information that may assist the Trial Chamber in determining an appropriate sentence and that it will reject any material relating to the guilt or innocence of Duško Tadić;

ORDERS the parties to advise the Trial Chamber, on or before 23 June 1997, of the amount of time that will be required to present each oral statement; and

ORDERS the presenting party to file with the Registry and serve on opposing counsel a written report of the content of the oral statements of psychiatrists, psychologists or other experts at least three (3) days prior to the Pre-Sentencing Hearing.
