THE APPEALS CHAMBER

HAVING CONSIDERED the Request for an extension of time filed by the Office of the Prosecutor ("Respondent") on 9 October 1997, seeking an extension of time from 6 October 1997 to 27 October 1997 in which to file a reply to the Appellant's "Motion for the Extension of the Time Limit", and the reasons given for such request,
