#### THE APPEALS CHAMBER

HAVING CONSIDERED the Request for an extension of time filed by the Office of the Prosecutor ("Respondent") on 9 October 1997, seeking an extension of time from 6 October 1997 to 27 October 1997 in which to file a reply to the Appellant's "Motion for the Extension of the Time Limit", and the reasons given for such request,

NOTING the Scheduling Order of the Appeals Chamber of 22 September 1997,
