
NOTING that the Defence for the four accused (“Defence”) have indicated their intention to file a motion for no case to answer in the present case (“Motion”);

PURSUANT TO RULE 54 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence,

HEREBY ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Defence shall file the Motion at or before 1:00 p.m on Friday, 20 February 1998;
2. The Office of the Prosecutor (the “Prosecution”) shall file its response to the Motion by Friday 6 March 1998 at 1:00 p.m.;
3. The Defence shall file its reply to the Prosecution’s response to the Motion by Tuesday 10 March 1998;
4. The Trial Chamber shall hear oral arguments on the Motion commencing on Wednesday 11 March 1998, at 10:00 a.m. and continuing, if necessary, on Thursday 12 and Friday 13 March 1998;
5. To the extent necessary, the Defence shall commence the presentation of its case on Monday 30 March 1998, at 10:00 a.m.
