- (1) The trial of this matter shall commence on 8 June 1998 in Courtroom II and shall continue until 18 June 1998 with further dates to be set in due course;
- (2) Unless otherwise indicated, the Trial Chamber shall sit in this matter from 9:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. and from 14:30 p.m. to 17:30 p.m.;
- (3) Exceptionally, on 18 June 1998 the Trial Chamber shall sit in this matter from 9:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. only.
