**THE APPEALS CHAMBER** of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991,

**NOTING** the Prosecutor's Request for Leave to File a Brief In Lieu of an Oral Hearing on the Appeal from the Trial Chamber's Denial of Prosecutor's Request for Leave to File an Amended Indictment ("Request"), filed on 24 April 1998,

**NOTING** the Prosecutor's Application for Leave to Appeal from the Trial Chamber's Denial of Prosecutor's Request for Leave to File an Amended Indictment, filed on 13 March 1998,

NOTING the Defendant's Response to the Prosecutor's Application filed on 8 April 1998,

**FURTHER NOTING** the Appeals Chamber's Decision on Application for Leave to Appeal by the Prosecution ("Decision"), dated 22 April 1998,

**CONSIDERING** that in its Decision the Appeals Chamber decided that the appeal "shall be heard expeditiously . . . without the necessity of any written briefs . . . and without oral hearing",

**FURTHER CONSIDERING** that in her Request the Prosecutor requests leave to file a brief, or in the alternative a reconsideration of the Decision excluding an oral hearing on the matter, in order to be given an equal opportunity to address fully her position regarding the issues on appeal,

**HEREBY ORDERS** that the parties may submit a written brief with respect to the issues designated in the Decision,

**ORDERS** the Prosecutor to file her brief by 5 p.m., Friday, 1 May 1998, which shall be faxed to the Defence,

**ORDERS** the Defence to file its brief by 5 p.m., Monday, 4 May 1998, which shall be immediatly provided to the Prosecutor,

Case No. IT-97-24-AR73

**ORDERS** that oral arguments with respect to the issues designated in the Appeals Chamber's Decision shall be heard at 4.00 p.m. on Tuesday 5 May 1998,

FURTHER ORDERS that each party shall be granted one hour to present its arguments.
