**THIS TRIAL CHAMBER** of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“International Tribunal”),

**BEING SEISED** of the “Prosecutor’s Motion for Extension of Time to File Amended Indictment” filed 18 March 1999 (“Motion”),

**NOTING** the “Decision on the Defence Preliminary Motion on the Form of the Indictment” issued by the Trial Chamber on 24 February 1999 (“Decision”), which directed the Prosecutor to, *inter alia*, file and serve an amended indictment by 26 March 1999 (“Time limit”),

**FURTHER NOTING** that, in the Motion, the prosecution seeks an extension of the Time limit to 23 April 1999 on the basis of the illness of one of its co-counsel,

**FURTHER NOTING** the Scheduling Order issued on 22 March 1999,


**FURTHER NOTING** the Defence response to the Motion, filed on 25 March 1999, wherein the Defence states that it does not oppose the Motion,

**CONSIDERING** the need to ensure a fair and expeditious trial pursuant to Article 20, paragraph 1, of the Statute of the International Tribunal (“Statute”),

**PURSUANT** to Article 20, paragraph 1 of the Statute and Rule 54 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the International Tribunal,

**HEREBY** grants the Motion and orders the prosecution to file and serve an amended indictment in accordance with the Decision on or before 23 April 1999.
