**NOTING** the Defendant Vinko Martinović's "Objection to the Indictment" dated 4 October 1999 and the Prosecutor's "Response to Defendant's Objection to the Indictment" dated 19 October 1999;


**NOTING** the request of the Government of the Republic of Croatia of 10 December 1999 for the Defendant Vinko Martinović's attendance at a retrial in Zagreb County Court;

**ORDERS** that the next Status Conference be held in closed session on Thursday, 3 February 2000, at 10 o'clock in the morning. The parties should be prepared for the following:

- (1) Argument on the Defendant's objection to the indictment;
- (2) Discussion of the Government of Croatia's request for Mr. Martinović's transfer to Zagreb for re-trial;
- (3) Discussion of other pre-trial matters.
