**NOTING** the “Prosecution Response to the Scheduling Order of 8 December 1999”, filed 11 January 2000, in which the Prosecution requests the opportunity to file a response to the Appellant’s Additional Submissions in relation to the defence of “extreme necessity” or “duress”,


**NOTING** that Zlatko Aleksovski did not file a reply by 21 January 2000 in accordance with Article 11 of the Practice Direction on Procedure for the Filing of Written Submissions in Appeal Proceedings before the International Tribunal (IT/155),

**PURSUANT TO** Rule 54 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the International Tribunal,

**HEREBY ORDERS** the Prosecution to file its response no later than Monday, 31 January 2000.
